



WORKSHOP : building of head and hands for professional puppet (hand, strings and table top types)



For every people used to practice manual activities. People interested or already involved in performance with puppets.

Objective :

Providing participants with the marks of proportions, the technique of strengthened modelling, the construction tricks for the building of a head (with glass eyes, sewn wig) and of a pair of hands with low weight and heavy duty characteristics.

Learning content :

Beyond the focus for realism, this workshop is especially aimed at the concerns for lightness and durability of head

and hands dedicated to be mounted on a professional puppet (hand, strings or table top types).

Trainer : Nadine Delannoy- plastic artist, creator of the « Ames imaginaires”

Number of participants : maximum 6

(a minimum of 5 registered persons is requested for confirming the workshop session)

Date: June the 1st to the 6th 2015 included

Duration : 6 days equivalent 42 h

Teaching hours : 9 h 30 - 13 h00 / 14 h00 – 17 h30

Teaching language : French, English and Spanish (if requested)

Programme :

- Transmission of strengthened modelling basic principles (marks of general proportions, technical obligations),
- Analysis of each project starting elements : (glove puppet, strings ones, table top ones, dimensions)
- Drawing on scale 1 (face and profile),
- Building of head core with or without backside control, insertion of glass eyes,
- Personalized modelling with air drying clay and hardening of outer surface,
- Emphasizing Painting,
- Creation of a wig sewn to the head size,
- Building of hand armature and personalized shaping of fingers position,
- Modelling of hands and painting.

Workshop fees : 560 €(*)

This amount is meant for people financing the training on their own.

It corresponds to the teaching charges and includes the necessary raw materials necessary for the building of a head and a pair of hands in the morphology of your choice.

It does not include the midday meal (shops around and possibility to use the fridge and microwave oven in L’Etablisienne)

International payment by bank transfer (see IBAN details on registration formular)

(*) VAT will not apply on above price (as per item 293 B of French tax general code).

Tools :

In the formula, we give access to the use of several kits of tooling. However, for your comfort and for minimizing waiting times, you can also bring your mini-drill machine (Dremel, Maxicraft, Proxxon...) if you have one..

Inscription process :

Session access being limited to 6 persons, your registration will be considered as a firm booking. It consists in returning us filled attached formular together with taking the necessary steps for international bank transfer of 160€ to our bank account (seen IBAN details on attached formular).

Cancellation :

In case of cancellation from your side, the 160€ amount will be kept.

In case we cannot maintain the workshop session (less than 5 persons registered 15 days before the starting day of session) we immediately proceed to bank refund .
